Assurances

- 1. Eaton Regional Education Service Agency (Eaton RESA) will make their Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan accessible through the transparency reporting link located on the district's website no later than October 1, 2024.
- 2. If delivering pupil instruction remotely, Eaton RESA will
 - provide pupils with equitable access to technology and the internet necessary to participate in instruction, and
 - expose each pupil to the academic standards that apply for each pupil's grade level or courses in the same scope and sequence as Eaton RESA had planned for that exposure to occur during face-to-face instruction.
- 3. Eaton RESA in consultation with a local health department will develop guidelines concerning appropriate methods for delivering pupil instruction for the 2024-2025 school year that are based on local data that are based on key metrics. <u>Note: A determination concerning the method for delivering pupil instruction shall remain at Eaton RESA's Board's discretion.</u> Key metrics that Eaton RESA will consider shall include at least all of the following:
 - COVID-19 Cases or Positive COVID-19 tests
 - Hospitalizations due to COVID-19
 - Number of deaths resulting from COVID-19 over a 14-day period
 - COVID-19 cases for each day for each 1 million individuals
 - The percentage of positive COVID-19 tests over a 4-week period
 - Health capacity strength
 - Testing, tracing, and containment infrastructure with regard to COVID-19
- If Eaton RESA determines that it is safe to provide face-to-face instruction to pupils, Eaton RESA will prioritize providing face-to-face instruction to pupils in grades K to 5 who are enrolled at Eaton RESA.
- Eaton RESA will ensure:
 - that instruction will be delivered as described in this plan and approved by the Eaton RESA Board,
 - the description of instructional delivery in this plan matches the delivery of instruction to be delivered during the 2024-2025 school year, and
 - will reconfirm how instruction will be delivered during the 2024-2025 school year.
- Eaton RESA will ensure that students with disabilities will be provided with
 equitable access to instruction and accommodation in accordance with applicable
 state and federal laws, rules and regulations.

7. Eaton RESA will ensure that two (2), 2-way interactions occur between a pupil enrolled in an Eaton RESA program or service, and the pupil's teacher or at least one (1) of the pupil's teachers during each week of the school year for at least 75% of the pupils enrolled at Eaton RESA. Eaton RESA will publicly announce its weekly interaction rates at each Eaton RESA Board meeting where it re-confirms how instruction is being delivered. Eaton RESA will make those rates available through the transparency reporting link located on the district's website each month for the 2024-2025 school year.
